

## Visa Application for a Russian Visa

The Russian Embassy requires one signed copy of the online visa application.

### Application Instructions:

1. Go to the visa application website: <http://evisa.kdmid.ru>.
2. Register by clicking on “Registration” which can be found on the upper right-hand corner of the website.
3. Enter your name as it appears on your passport.
4. You will be given a “DeclarantId” and a password. WRITE BOTH on a piece of paper as you may need them in the future. Click the box next to “I remember my DeclarantId and password” and you will be taken back to the main page.
5. At the top of the page you will see the option to “CREATE NEW APPLICATION.”
6. Follow the steps to fill out the application. Be sure to have ready the registration number of the travel company or hotel that you have made reservations with, and your confirmation information from that hotel or company.
7. It will ask for your appointment date. Unless otherwise pr-arranged with one of our representatives, this will be the day after we receive your visa application. Be sure to choose Washington, DC, as the location where you will be applying and click on “Save and Submit.”
8. You will be taken to a page where you can edit your application, or print it. Click “Print in Letter” and follow the directions to print ONE copy of the application.
9. Sign the application in the space provided on page two under the barcode, and submit it to us along with the other application materials.

NOTE: Improperly completed forms may delay the processing of your visa. The signature on each Russian visa application must be original.
